## Round-Up for 2018-2019

### **Pre-K and Kindergarten Classes**

Pre-K: Thursday, April 19<sup>th</sup> @ 8:30

This is the ONLY date to apply for this program for next year.

Children born October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014 may apply for enrollment (4 years old by Sept. 30, 2018)

A screening day/time will be given to you on this date. We will only screen applicants who register on this date. Only 20 students will be selected by the Pre-K department to take part in the program. You will be notified of the results during the summer. Parents of students accepted for the Pre-K program must attend a Parent Orientation meeting and sign a Parent contract.



#### Pre-K parents MUST provide proof of income before we can accept registration.

This must be **two** current consecutive check stubs within last 2 months of application date for **each** parent or caregiver in the home. If more than two adults are contributing to support, all household members must submit proof of income.

If \$0 income, you must submit a letter of support and income documentation from support source.

Or, you may show your current SNAP benefits letter—not card.

# Kindergarten: Friday, April 20<sup>th</sup> @ 8:30

Children must be 5 years old by September 30, 2018 to be eligible for Kindergarten. Birthdate prior to October 1, 2013.

A transition meeting will be held first followed by registration.

# **Pre-K and K must** have copies of the following materials before you may register:

- 1. Birth Certificate from the Bureau of Vital Statistics
- 2. Health Card signed by a doctor or stamped by the Health Unit
- 3. Social Security card of child
- 4. Proof of Residence- Two current utility bills (gas, water, electric only) of parent or legal guardian—must be dated within last 45 days. Telephone and cable bill not accepted.
- 5. Driver's License with current address listed—<u>Pre K MUST</u> have DL with current address. Kindergarten, if not same address, then another legal bill is required.
- 6. Stamped, Self-addressed, legal size (#10) envelope with child's first and last name. (To parents of ...)

\*\*\*If you are living with someone else within our school district, you will need a notarized affidavit of residency and two legal pieces of mail which list your name as residing at the address. In addition, the owner of the home must produce two current utility bills at the residence.
